Following the successful tomes on Science, Philosophy and Religion, author Margreet de Heer brings her innate talent for distilling tough subjects into their most approachable with one that may appear a lot lighter but is an emotional battleground.

We can never get enough counseling and advice on this aspect, a need we all have deeply but which can be so laden with soaring highs and wracking lows.

“The heart has its reasons, which reason does not know...” once said French philosopher Blaise Pascal, and that is what makes the subject so difficult to navigate. Logic may have little to do with it. As much as we try hard to bring one to the other, this is a very personal subject, different for each person.

Yet, as brilliantly as de Heer has tackled such abstruse subjects as Philosophy and Religion and, with an open mind so typical of the Dutch (as she is), she presents all flavors of love from casual lovemaking to how to best find your life’s companion.

As she always does, she makes herself and husband Yiri the host and narrator bringing a personal point of view from her own experience and having a one on one discussion with the reader. She delves into everything from Advice to my 17 Year-Old Self to the Kama Sutra, The Perfect Moment, How Do You Keep Things Good?, The Tragedy of Romance, What Happens When You Fall in Love, Love Addiction, to the Seven Year Itch and The Dark Side of Love. She keeps it light but very clear and informative, indeed even therapeutic, in distilling such a subject fraught with complexity to something so refreshingly simple. You’ll come out of this with a bulb above your head “Of Course!” Well, hopefully...

This is Margreet’s fourth installment in the “Discovery in Comics” series. *Philosophy, A Discovery in Comics* (2012), *Science, A Discovery in Comics* (2013), and *Religion, A Discovery in Comics* (2015) have been widely used in classroom settings, bringing new ways of teaching tricky subjects. *Science* was a YALSA Great Graphic Novels for Teens nominee and *Philosophy* was a BEA 2012 Hot Graphic Novel mention.
